Tour Itinerary

DAY 1 : MONDAY MAY 25TH | STIRLING, ARGYLL & FORT WILLIAM

After landing in Edinburgh airport this morning, you will travel first to Stirling where you'll stop to visit Stirling Castle (self-guided admission). Next stop will be at Doune Castle, for a photo op of the Outlander series location. Continue to Glencoe to experience the spectacular mountain pass, which was the scene of the great massacre of the Clan MacDonald in 1692. A short drive to Fort William follows where you will stay overnight and have dinner on your own.

DAY 2 : TUESDAY MAY 26TH | ISLE OF SKYE

Today we are headed to the Glenfinnan Monument and Visitor Center. Afterwards, we will take the Mallaig-Armadale ferry over to the Isle of Skye, where you will have a local guide with you for a half-day tour of the Isle, including some free time in the main town of Portree. The group will return to Ft. William for overnight, since Skye's hotels are too small to house a large group. On the return journey you will stop for a photo op of Eilean Donan Castle.

DAY 3 : WEDNESDAY MAY 27TH | FORT WILLIAM TO INVERNESS

After breakfast we depart from Fort William and make our way to Inverness via Loch Ness. Enjoy an afternoon cruise on the loch which offers unique views of Urquhart Castle. After arrival in Inverness the remainder of the evening is free at your leisure.

DAY 4 : THURSDAY MAY 28TH | DUNROBIN CASTLE & CULLODEN BATTLEFIELD

Boarding your coach today you will travel to Sutherland, we visit Dunrobin Castle where you will see the gardens, museum, and falconry display. Then continue onto Culloden, here you will have time to explore the Culloden Battlefield and Visitor Centre. Return to Inverness where your evening is free.

DAY 5 : FRIDAY MAY 29TH | INVERNESS TO EDINBURGH

Depart Inverness for Edinburgh. Along the way we will stop in the quaint town of Pitlochry where you will have time to explore the town and have lunch at a local restaurant (*not included*). In the afternoon we will visit the Blair Athol whiskey distillery for a tour and tasting. Onto Edinburgh for your last night in Scotland.

DAY 6 : SATURDAY MAY 30TH | EDINBURGH TO BELFAST

This morning, we will take a flight from Edinburgh to Belfast (*not included in land package pricing*). This afternoon in we will visit Titanic Belfast, the remainder of the day is free in the city. Overnight in Belfast.

DAY 7 : SUNDAY MAY 31ST | GIANTS CAUSEWAY AND BELFAST

Enjoy a scenic drive along the Antrim Coast while we visit the Giants Causeway. Return to Belfast in the afternoon, the remainder of the day is free for you to enjoy the city at your leisure. Dinner is on your own.

DAY 8 : MONDAY JUNE 1ST | BELFAST TO DONEGAL

After breakfast we travel to Donegal via Derry. Enjoy a walking tour of Derry with a local guide and some time for lunch on our own. In the afternoon we will visit Glenveagh Castle and Gardens before ending our day in Donegal town. Dinner is on your own tonight.

DAY 9 : TUESDAY JUNE 2ND | DONEGAL

Today we will tour around the beautiful Donegal region. First, we will visit the Slieve League Cliffs, with time for lunch at a local café, then to the Triona Tweed Center where you will get a demonstration on how their tweed is woven, before continuing onto the Wild Atlantic Distillery for a tour and tasting. Return to Donegal Town for overnight. Dinner will be on your own.

DAY 10 : WEDNESDAY JUNE 3RD | DONEGAL TO MULLINGAR

This morning, we head to Belleek Pottery for a tour of the factory and lunch at the onsite Tea Room. From Belleek we head back towards the east coast, ending our day outside of the town of Mullingar at our hotel located on the north side of Lough Ennell. You will have time to relax before tonight's Farewell Dinner.

DAY 11 : THURSDAY JUNE 4TH | TOUR ENDS!

An early morning transfer brings you to Dublin airport for your flight back to the USA.

Cancellation – Land Penalty: Written cancellation notice is required for all cancellations and if received by Celtic Tours more than 125-96 days prior to departing, a processing fee of the LAND PORTION of \$300 per person will apply, plus any non-refundable fees for land portion of tours. From 95 to 66 days prior to departure a cancellation fee of \$350 per person will apply, plus any non-refundable fees. From 65 to 46 days prior to departure a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour cost will apply. Within 45 days of departure date 100% cancellation fee applies. Single room supplement will be required in the situation that a shared room is converted to single room due to a cancellation. Cancellations must be made during Celtic Tours business hours, Monday – Friday, 9am to 5pm EST. Travel Insurance is available at an additional cost p.p. and is recommended. Travel insurance must be purchased with initial reservation/deposit in order to cover pre existing conditions. Due to Covid-19's effect on the current worldwide financial markets, exchange rates are currently fluctuating much more rapidly than normal. This does have an affect on international travel. At 125 days prior to your departure the exchange rates will be reviewed and guaranteed. Any applicable rate changes (higher or lower) will be advised for final payment in 30 days. Rates will only change if exchange rates vary by more than 3% in either direction of the quoted rate. Celtic Tours will do everything within its power to keep rates consistent with quoted rates, but there are times it may be beyond our control.
